

Annual General Meeting



OCUA recognizes gender as a spectrum, and believes people of all genders have the right to play sport and feel included. This is why OCUA continues to use our new gender roster categories.

- **GN2** stands for Girls, Non-Binary, and Two-Spirit players
- WN2 stands for Women, Non-Binary, and Two-Spirit players
- ON2 stands for Open, Non-Binary, and Two-Spirit players

OCUA does not distinguish between cis- and trans- for purposes of roster categories. Non-binary and two-spirit players may participate as their authentic selves without needing to register as a man or a woman.

March 8th was International Women's Day, and this year's theme was Embrace Equity. We embrace equity for women. We embrace equity for diverse genders. We embrace equity for all. We joined the #EmbraceEquity movement by striking the pose! We also held special WN2 and GN2 events to celebrate!
